PREPARING FOR YOUR FIRST APPOINTMENT

If you are having symptoms of retinal disease, it is important to be evaluated and treated in a timely manner. However, retinal diseases may also be present even though there are not yet any symptoms or vision loss. If your primary eye care provider has recommended that you see a retina specialist, it is important to complete the first appointment and follow-up appointments as recommended in order to prevent vision loss. Retinal diseases can be due to many reasons, including aging, diabetes, autoimmune or inflammatory diseases, trauma to the eye, or family history.

To check and monitor retinal disease, an eye exam with dilation is necessary. Dilation of the eyes will take 30-45 minutes, and will also affect your vision after the appointment for several hours. If possible, a family member or friend should accompany you to the appointment to drive you home afterward.

A thorough retinal evaluation with diagnostic testing, if indicated, will be performed at your first appointment. In some cases, we may recommend treatment on the same day. Because of this, some visits may be lengthier than others. Overall, your first appointment can last up to 3 hours.
